

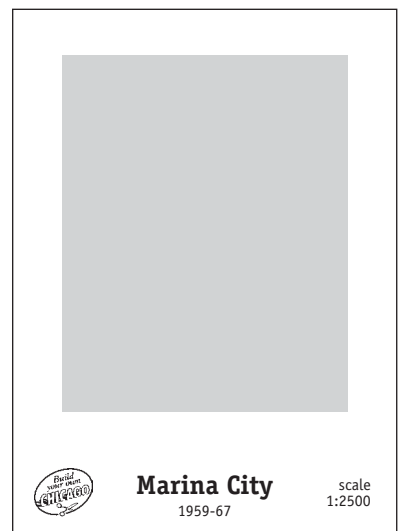
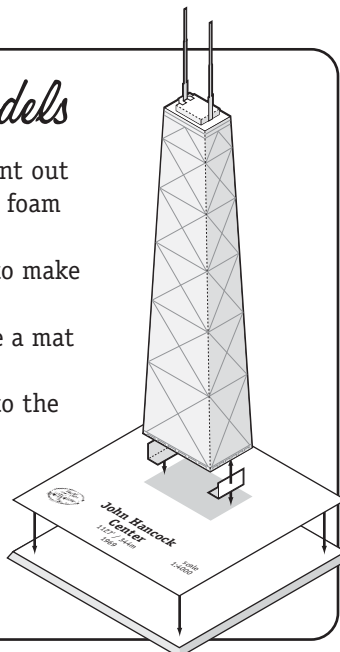
## Display Stands for Your Models

To make display stands for your models, first print out this page on plain paper. Glue to stiff mat board or foam core to provide a sturdy base.


Press the boards under a heavy book overnight to make sure the base does not warp as the glue dries.

Trim to the bases to the correct size. If you have a mat cutter you can create beveled edges.

You may glue the bottom of the model directly to the base, or add tabs made from scrap paper inside and underneath the model, to create a flat surface to be glued more securely to the base.










